


Lab-MOVIE 2nd Transnational Meeting (online) – Feedback evaluation

The attending partners were asked to provide feedback about the meeting organization: here below the main results.


Most partners were happy about the **structure and organization of the meeting**, in spite of the different conditions due to the online format, that was used rather than the traditional face-to-face one:




The majority also agrees that the **agenda was comprehensive** and conclusive, as well as the allocated **time to each topic** was enough.

14 responses




The allocated time to each topic was sufficient
14 responses




The **presentations** were considered to be useful and informative, also because the partners were well prepared and **knowledgeable** about their allocated tasks

14 responses




The partners were well prepared and knowledgeable about their allocated tasks

Even if the virtual settings did not allow the same interactions as if in the presence meeting, all the partners confirmed that there was enough **time for discussions** and exchange of ideas, which is also a good improvement from the previous meeting evaluation.

Participants also agreed that foreseen and upcoming **tasks** together with partner roles were clearly explained, and that generally speaking the meeting as a whole has been **appropriate and productive**.

The partners underlined the **aspects of the meeting that were particularly good**:

- The good preparation and description of **WP1 reports**
- The explanation about **staff cost**
- The comments and **feedbacks from partners**
- The clear **structure of the meeting**: outcomes and decisions have been reached and agreed on.
- The **collaboration and participation** among partners in spite of this tough situation
- There was a chairperson to **lead the meeting** smoothly run

From the above comments, partners seem to appreciate most of all the **collaborative approach** of partners and the efficient **management of the meeting**, which are key aspects for the successful efficiency of the project.

On the other hand, only several aspects seemed to require **improvements**:

- the part of **dissemination**,
- specific **guidelines** for implementing the tasks, with deadlines for activities,
- more participation and **interaction from the Vietnamese Partners** would be welcome.
