



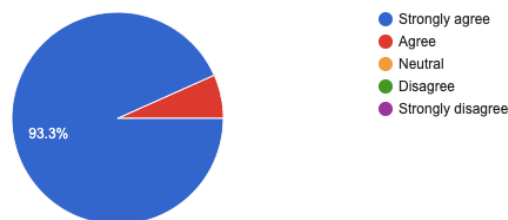
Lab-MOVIE Kick Off Meeting – Feedback evaluation

The meeting was properly structured and organised

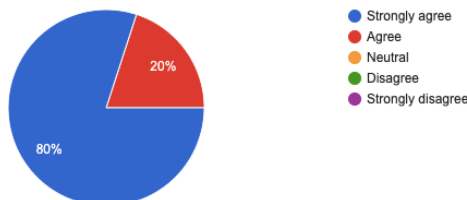

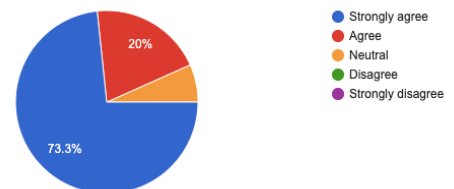
The agenda was comprehensive and conclusive

The allocated time to each topic was sufficient

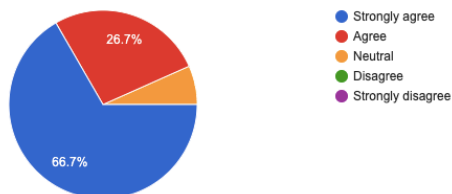

The **presentations** were considered to be useful and informative, also because the partners were well prepared and **knowledgeable** about their allocated tasks

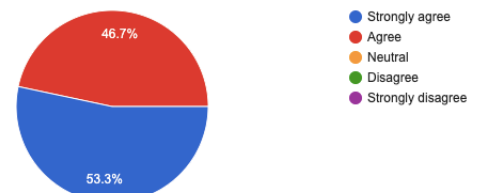
The presentations were useful and informative

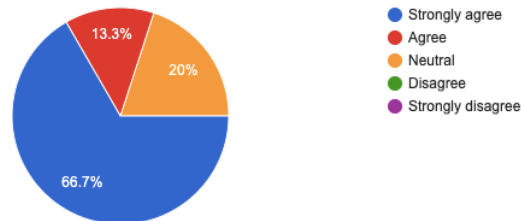
The partners were well prepared and knowledgeable about their allocated tasks

- The understanding about **work plan** and roles of each partners
- The **agenda** was really well organized so the time was used in a fruitful way. Also enough time to know each other was foreseen since the partnership is quite wide and there are a lot of culture and legislative differences.
- The "**meeting**" part of the meeting: identifying our partners for the future work so that we can progress in the project development. Identifying the key aspects of the project.
